Pray For the Nations

Nepal

Most of the persecution of Christians in Nepal comes from Hindu radical groups whose goal is to return Nepal to a Hindu state. Seen as betraying their ancestors' faith, Christian converts from Hinduism continue to live under intense pressure, including Nepal's anti-conversion laws. Before the adoption of a new constitution in 2015 that limits freedom of religion, the government didn't drive persecution. On August 8, 2017, the Nepalese parliament also passed anti-conversion legislation—another sign of a deteriorating situation for Christians. (Open Doors)

Pray for Nepali's Christian to withstand persecution.

Pray that bold witness will win people to Jesus.

Pray for the spread of the gospel.

Young people comprise two-thirds of Nepal's population. Not finding hope, purpose and meaning, they are vulnerable to exploitation, trafficking, drug abuse and radicalization. (Operation World) *Pray for Nepali's young people to find the hope of Jesus*.

Pray that God will intervene against cultural immorality.

Mongolia

Christianity in Mongolia is a reality for the first time in modern history! The Church is less than one generation old, but it already sends missionaries to unreached areas. There have been some challenges in governmental leadership. There has been a resurgence of traditional religions. (Operation World) *Pray that Mongolian leaders will rule with fairness and wisdom.*

Pray that Mongolians will find complete liberation and find transformation through Jesus Christ. Pray for the development of Mongolian Church leaders.

Pray that Mongolia remains open to Christianity.

South Sudan

South Sudan is the world's newest country. It is also one of the world's poorest nations. Only 27% of the people can read and write. Less than 2% of the people have access to clean water and 33% suffer from chronic hunger. The civil war which led to the creation of South Sudan lasted for 21 years and people still suffers from the horrors of war. Christianity grew rapidly over the past 20 years amid violence, warfare and persecution. Most new believers need shepherding and discipleship. (Operation World)

Pray for good Bible teaching and leadership training.

Pray that young Christians will be discipled to maturity.

Pray that the gospel will lift this nation out of poverty and injustice.

Albania

Thank God for His work in Albania. For a long time, this nation was closed to the gospel but there are now several thousand believers. Even so, Albania has a long road to recover from the devastation of atheistic communism. Economically, morally, and especially spiritually, there is much to be done.

Pray for leadership training which is greatly needed as the Church grows.

Pray for receptivity of Bible instruction to alleviate Biblical illiteracy.

Pray for evangelism and Church planting.

Pray for holistic ministries designed to help the poor and suffering.

A common prayer in all of these nations is a strengthening of the local Church with a depth of discipleship. Pray that the local Church would mature and grow. Pray that people with no hope would find hope in Jesus.
